## *Please enclose the following with your application*

- › Application form
- › Curriculum vitae with photo
- › Degree certificate or corresponding transcript of records
- › A portfolio, not larger than A3 size, which may not be submitted exclusively in digital format. The portfolio should contain the applicant's bachelor project and other outstanding pieces of their project work.
- › Proposal: a maximum of five A4 pages, in which the applicant elaborates on a final master project he or she might have planned or a preferred field of interest within the M.A. course.
- › Completed questionnaire *Editorial Design*
- › For applicants from abroad: proof of sufficient knowledge of German. In individual cases, the course can be started with sufficient knowledge of English.
