- › Application form

- › Portfolio, relevant samples of your work, not larger than A4 size. The contents of the portfolio should also be delivered as a pdf on CD or DVD.
- › Proposal: a maximum of two A4 pages, on which you describe your motivation for this degree course and possible subjects for your M.A. project.
- › For applicants from abroad: proof of sufficient knowledge of German. In individual cases, the course can be started with sufficient knowledge of English.
