Return of application material

Application materials can be collected in person once notification with the result of the suitability test has been received. Application materials can only be returned if sufficient postage and packaging for this purpose is enclosed upon submission. Documents that have not been collected or for which sufficient postage has not been provided will be destroyed one year after the suitability test.

Please enclose the following with your application

- › Application form
- › Curriculum vitae in the form of a personal data sheet with photo
- › Degree certificate or corresponding transcript of records
- › Portfolio: the portfolio should contain at least twenty-five pieces. Expressive photography plus perhaps some design works (all in original copy). The portfolio should be sized 30×40 cm or A3. Data storage mediums e.g. CD, DVD etc. are excluded.
- › Letter of Motivation: the letter of motivation should be about two pages long. The first part should include the reasons for participating in the M.A. programme. The second part of the text should list your previous knowledge and any work experience relevant to the M.A. programme.
- › For applicants from abroad: proof of sufficient knowledge of German. In individual cases, the course can be started with sufficient knowledge of English.
