Letter of Motivation	This letter is your chance to express why you want to go abroad and why you chose to apply to Burg Giebichenstein University of Art and Design specifically. Remember that professors receive many applications and that they will want some time to look at your portfolio. Don't exceed one page if you don't have to;)	<input type="checkbox"/>
Curriculum Vitae	What are your stations of life so far? Keep it simple. Example: It's important for your creative work that you work as a nanny? Great, include it! It's not important? No need to list it.	<input type="checkbox"/>
